1. HAVE YOUR SAY

Just do a brief presentation of yourself: name, age, profession, residence and give us your opinion on some of the topics of your concern.

2. QUESTION THE PARLIAMENT

Here you can ask a question (on film and/or in writing) to the Parliament or an MEP (use the same procedure than in HAVE YOUR SAY section: name, age...).

Make sure you include your details: name, surname, country, nationality, date of birth and profession (if student, specify your studies) - plus a sentence saying that you own the rights of the material you have sent and that you agree to release those 'rights' for the use of the Europarl WebTV site.
